Why partner with Mental Illness Education ACT?

Mental Illness Education ACT (MIEACT) is a Canberra-based not-for-profit organisation working to reduce stigma and increase literacy around mental health across the Canberra community.

In any one year, 20 per cent of Australians aged 16-85 will experience a mental illness.

Young people have the highest prevalence of mental illness than any other age group in Australia, and suicide is the main cause of death among Australians aged 15-24.

As the primary local mental health and well-being education provider in the ACT, MIEACT provides mental health education for primary and secondary schools free of charge, as well as programs to workplaces and community groups across Canberra and the surrounding region.

For more than two decades, MIEACT has delivered evidence-informed programs. Through partnering with people with lived experience of mental illness, we share stories that increase mental health literacy, promote early intervention, reduce stigma, and emphasise recovery across the community.

Why now?

In 2023, Mental Illness Education ACT has experienced a truly unprecedented level of demand for our school programs.

Booking requests from schools already exceeding our delivery capacity for the first six months of 2023 by 119 sessions.

Supporting us to meet this increased demand across Canberra's community will ensure that MIEACT can seize and transform a unique moment into a deeper and more permanent engagement.

This allows us to facilitate a deeper and more permanent opportunity to raise student mental health literacy, achieving effective self-care, symptom recognition positive help-seeking, stigma reduction, and good mental health for our children and young people.

MIEACT historically has been heavily reliant on local Government funding, which we understand cannot be increased at this time.





At MIEACT, we do our events a little differently...

In 2022, we held our Inaugural Gala Ball at the National Museum of Australia, bringing together over 300 business leaders, politicians, and members of the Canberra community as well as our staff, and amazing Volunteer Educators who have lived experiences of mental illness.

Together, we participated in a live fundraising pledge for our Thriving Minds: Empowered Futures primary school program, which is now up and running, and undertaking a two-year evaluation by the Australian National University.

We ate delicious food, danced to good tunes, and importantly, had poignant conversations about breaking down stigma, and changing the trajectory for young people facing mental illness.

This year, we will be encouraging businesses to purchase a table of ten, with two reserved spaces for our incredible Volunteer Educators to join you on the evening.

At MIEACT, we are truly proud to be a safe space for mental health education. Our events are inclusive places for people of diverse cultures, abilities and experiences of mental illness. This means we do things a little differently with additional considerations to ensure our attendees' wellbeing.

Our events include all the fun, and no hangover! As we host dry events, we work with local companies to provide delicious, alcohol-free options everyone can enjoy.
